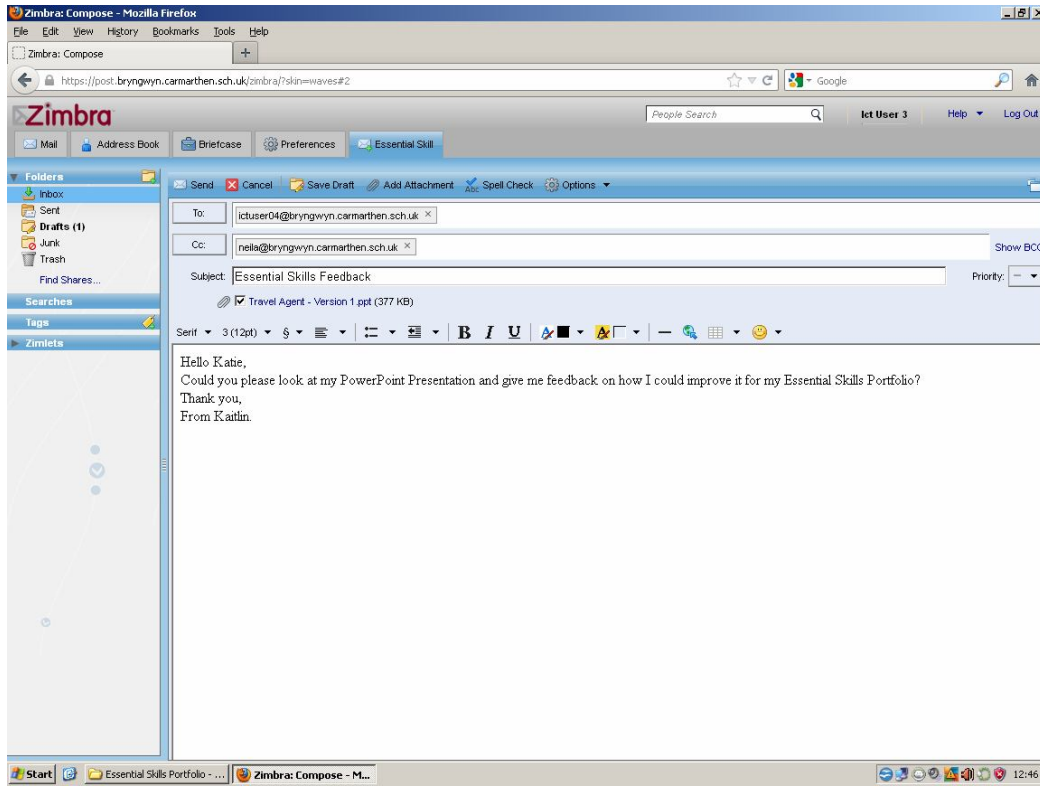
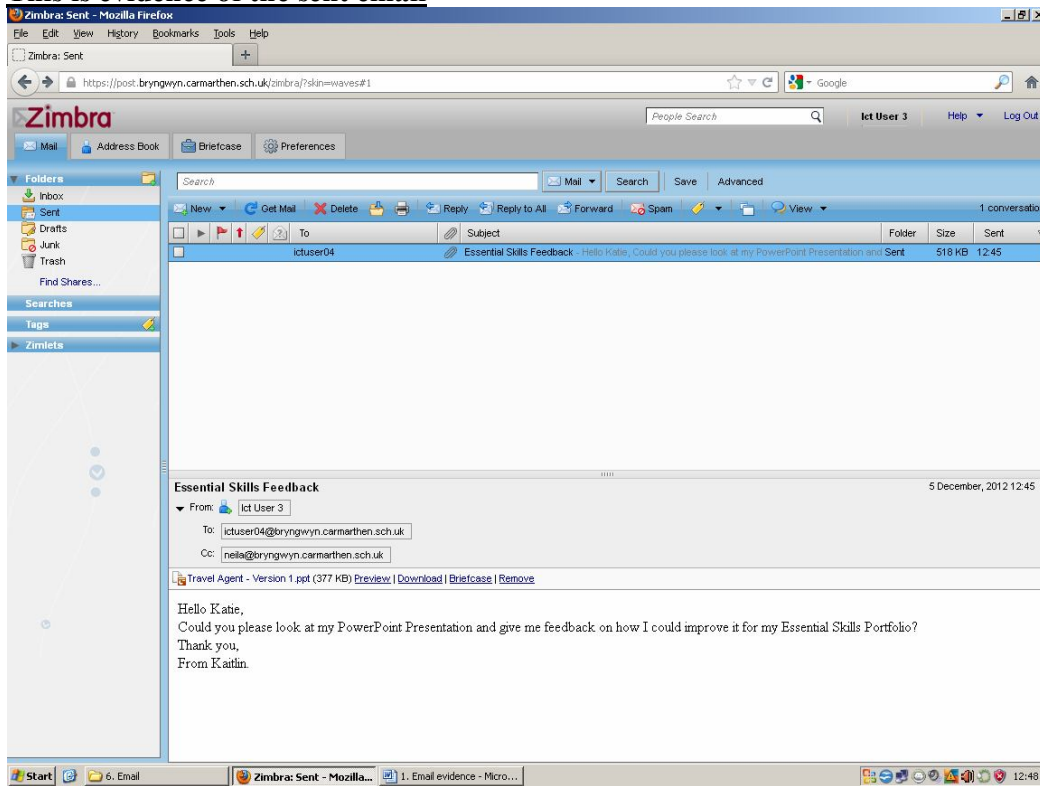

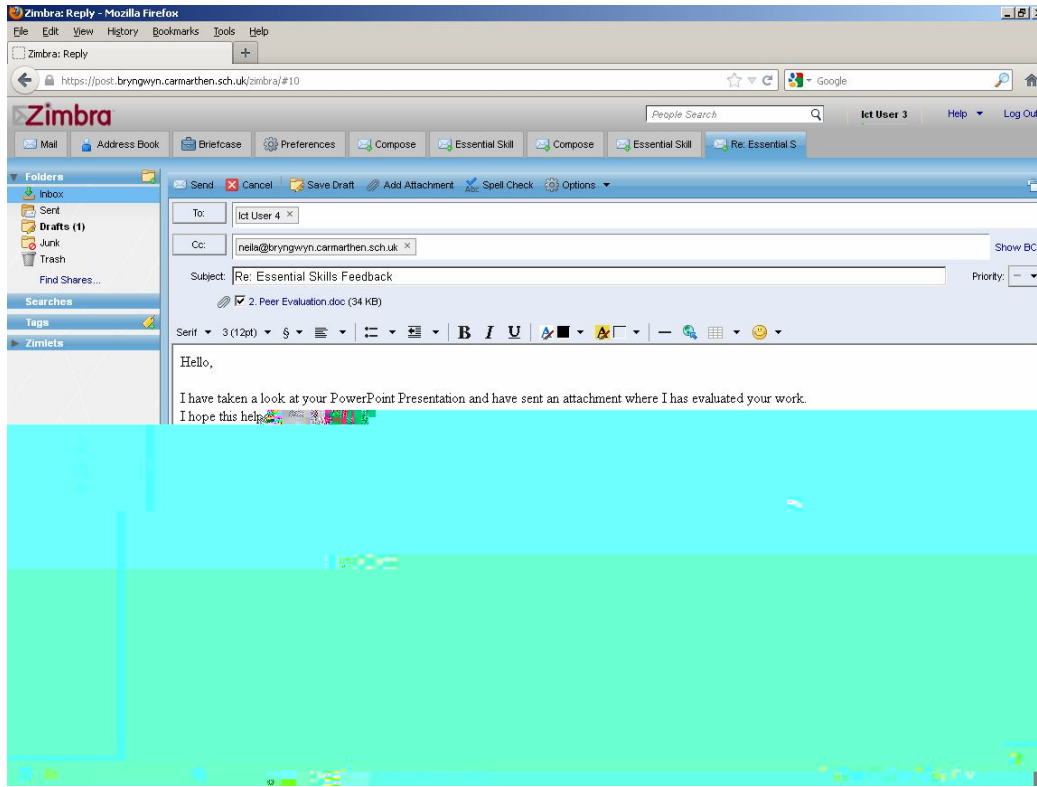
Evidence of sending an email with an attachment to my friend and my teacher using the carbon copy (cc) feature.



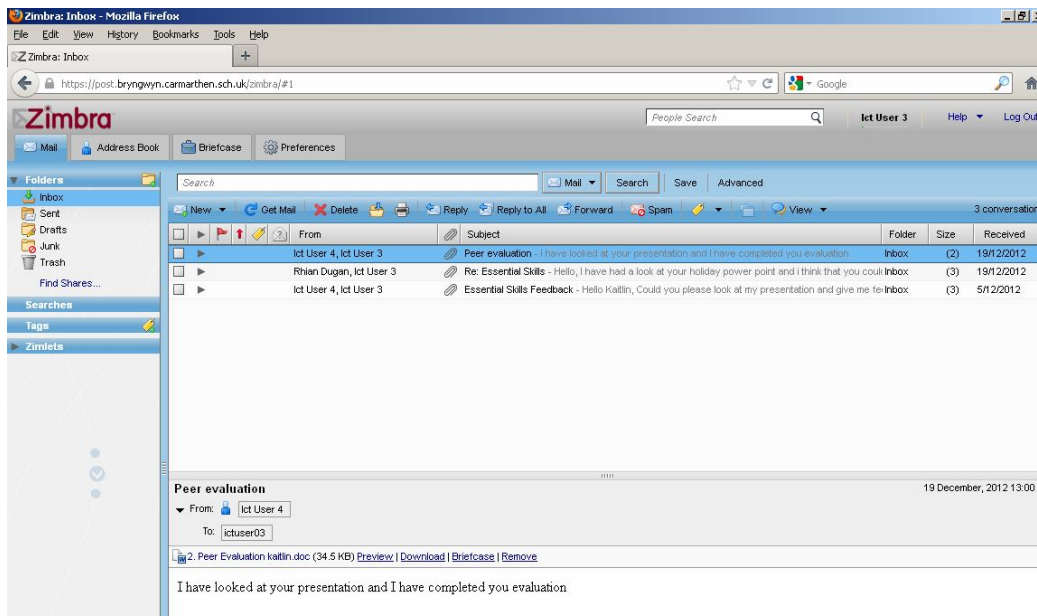


